

RESOLUTION NO. R-2016-30

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A GRANT APPLICATION WITH THE EAST TEXAS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS FOR A REGIONAL SOLID WASTE GRANTS PROGRAM GRANT; AUTHORIZING RACHEL NORTHCUTT, KEEP TYLER BEAUTIFUL COORDINATOR TO ACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF TYLER IN ALL MATTERS RELATED TO THE APPLICATION; PLEDGING THAT IF A GRANT IS RECEIVED THE CITY OF TYLER WILL COMPLY WITH THE GRANT REQUIREMENTS OF THE EAST TEXAS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS, THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY AND THE STATE OF TEXAS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF TYLER SOLID WASTE DEPARTMENT TO ACCEPT THE GRANT AND ANY GRANT AMENDMENTS TO INCREASE FUNDING LEVELS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF TYLER SOLID WASTE DEPARTMENT TO TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO ACCEPT THE GRANT; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the East Texas Council of Governments is directed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality to administer solid waste grant funds for implementation the COG's adopted regional solid waste management plan; and

WHEREAS, City of Tyler in the State of Texas is qualified to apply for grant funds under the Request for Applications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER TEXAS;

PART1: That Rachel Northcutt, Keep Tyler Beautiful Community Coordinator, is authorized to request grant funding under the East Texas Council of Governments Request for Applications of the Regional Solid Waste Grants Program and act on behalf of City of Tyler in all matters related to the grant application and any subsequent grant contract and grant project that may result.

PART 2: That if the project is funded, City of Tyler will comply with the grant requirements of the East Texas Council of Governments, Texas Commission on Environmental Quality and the State of Texas.

PART 3: The grant funds and any grant-funded equipment or facilities will be used only for the purposes for which they are intended under the grant.


PART 4: That activities will comply with and support the adopted regional and local solid waste management plans adopted for the geographical area in which the activities are performed.

PART 5: That the City of Tyler Solid Waste Department is hereby authorized and directed to accept the grant if awarded, and any grant amendments to increase the funding levels.

PART 6: That the City of Tyler Solid Waste Department is hereby authorized and directed to take all actions necessary to accept the grant to fulfill the purposes described above, if awarded.

PART 7: That this Resolution shall become effective upon its passage and approval.


