<u>Susan Guthrie, Communications Director</u> – Stated that in early 2010, the Tyler City Council and several other community boards and elected bodies came together in an historic undertaking to jointly adopt a measure to support the Industry Growth Initiative (IGI). The IGI is a twenty-year plan that contains strategic tactics focused on achieving an Innovation Economy which brings higher paying jobs, economic growth, job creation and a higher standard of living.

<u>Jeff Holliday</u>, <u>Texas HCN</u> – Stated that the tax incentive makes up about 60% of the Rainy Day Fund and it is the largest contributing tax into the Rainy Day Fund. If the State budget had to be dipped into to use the Rainy Day fund that the tax incentive would replenish that money as it is currently written in the next two years.

Mark McDaniel, City Manager, Murphy Parks and Dan Sefko, Freese and Nichols, and Mark Priestner, Planning Concepts were all in agreement with the plan and stated that that in October 2009, City of Tyler Council authorized Freese and Nichols, Inc., (F&N) to develop the Lake Tyler Master Plan. Under this agreement F&N worked closely with citizens, the Lake Tyler Roundtable, various stakeholder groups and City staff to develop a master plan which addresses the community's desire for enhanced utilization for the areas surrounding Lake Tyler and Lake Tyler East. Direct public input was received via various meetings and surveys,

with the Lake Tyler Roundtable serving as a project steering committee under the leadership of Councilman Mezayek.

The Lake Tyler Master Plan focuses on four main areas to:

- Protect the Water Quality of Lake Tyler and Lake Tyler East
- Balance Lake Benefits for Citizens of Tyler and Lake Tyler/Lake Tyler East Residents/Users
- Establish Partnerships between City of Tyler and Lake Tyler Lease Holders
- Create Recreation Opportunities for Citizens of Tyler and Lake Tyler/Lake Tyler East Residents/Users

Councilmember Mezayek – Thanked the Lake Tyler Round Group committee for their hard work and input.

<u>David Stoner</u>, 18185 Concession Rd – Stated that the marina will not be self-supportive six months out of the year without the RV Park. Asked City Council to consider the idea of the two weeks should be the maximum stay in an RV Park. No other RV Park in the State of Texas operates that way and this RV Park will not work that way.
