- C-A-5 Request that the City Council consider adopting a Resolution declaring a used 1997 Pierce Freightliner Fire Truck to be surplus property, making specific findings of a public purpose and other findings, and authorizing the donation of said surplus fire truck to HOPE-Ignited, a non-profit organization. (R-2014-21)
