Community Service Worker Dress Code

- Shorts are not recommended. If worn, they must reach knee length.
- Skirts/dresses are not recommended. If worn, they must reach knee length.
- Pajamas tops or bottoms are not permitted.
- Closed toe shoes are required.
- Flip flops are not permitted.
- Tops or shirts with images or lettering deemed by library staff to be offensive are not allowed.
- Low cut tops and low-rise bottoms are not allowed.
- Spaghetti straps are not allowed. (Lingerie straps should be covered)

In general, clothing should be suitable for physical labor. Community service workers will be assisting and working at the direction of the library custodians in a variety of duties.

Duties may include, but are not limited to: Mopping, dusting, sweeping, trash collecting (including pushing a rolling can), using cleaning chemicals, etc.

Dress Code suitability is at the discretion of library staff, including library custodian and the Library Operations Specialist. Workers not meeting dress code may be asked to leave and return in suitable attire.
