RESOLUTION NO. R-2024-7

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT GRANT FUNDING FROM THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION, FOR THE PURCHASE OF THIRTY-ONE (31) BALLISTIC RIFLE SHIELDS; DESIGNATING THE CITY'S AUTHORIZED OFFICIAL; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Tyler finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Tyler that the established Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office Criminal Justice Division funding be utilized for the 2024-2025 year; and

WHEREAS, The City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office Criminal Justice Division funds, the Tyler City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full; and

WHEREAS, the City Council designates the City Manager as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant, to accept any increases in grant funding, and/or take all necessary actions related to the grant, on behalf of the applicant agency; and

WHEREAS, The Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office Criminal Justice Division will fund the proposed equipment in the amount of \$99,475.28 for one year only, after which additional funding must be reapplied for; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS;

PART 1: That the City Council of the City of Tyler hereby approves the application and acceptance of the grant funding through the Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office Criminal Justice Division in the amount not to exceed \$99,475.28, to assist in funding up to thirty-one (31) ballistic rifle shields for the Tyler Police Department for one year.

PART 2: That the City Manager is hereby designated as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant, to accept any increases in grant funding, and/or take all necessary actions related to the grant, on behalf of the applicant agency; and

PART 3: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
