

RESOLUTION NO. R-2024-9

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT FUNDING FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE THROUGH THE EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) TO FUND THE PURCHASE OF PANASONIC TOUGHBOOK IN-CAR LAPTOP COMPUTERS WITH ADAPTORS; DESIGNATING THE CITY'S AUTHORIZED OFFICIAL; AUTHORIZING ALL NECESSARY ACTIONS RELATED TO ACCEPTANCE AND USE OF THE GRANT; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City Council of the City of Tyler to promote the public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Tyler that the established Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) funding be utilized for the 2024-2025 year; and

WHEREAS, The City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Justice Assistance Grant funds, the Tyler City Council assures that the funds will be returned in full; and

WHEREAS, The City Council designates the City Manager as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager is hereby authorized to take all necessary actions, including the use and expenditure of funds, related to the grant on behalf of the City of Tyler; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Justice, through the Justice Assistance Grant will fund the proposed equipment in the amount of up to \$47,925.02 for one year only, after which additional funding must be reapplied for

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS;

PART 1: That the City Council of the City of Tyler hereby approves the acceptance of Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) funding through the Department of Justice, and is not to exceed \$47,925.02, to assist in funding Panasonic Toughbook in-car laptop computers and adaptors for the Tyler Police Department for one year.

PART 2: That the City Manager is hereby designated as the City of Tyler's authorized official, and is hereby authorized to apply for, reject, alter, terminate, and/or take all necessary actions, including the use and expenditure of funds, related to the grant on behalf of the City of Tyler;

PART 3: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
