Landscaped Area Requirements

Commercial and Office Districts? Landscaped Area = 15% of total lot

> A minimum of 30% of landscaped area is required on the street yard for lots abutting one street.

The minimum width of required landscaping in the street yard is 10 ft. for properties abutting major arterial streets.




A minimum of 45% of landscaped area is required in the street yard for corner lots.

- Landscaping required only when off-street parking is installed 2.5% of total lot area Required for M-1 and M-2 **Industrial?**
- **Residential Districts?** 1 tree per residential lot

How Many Trees Do I Need?

Option A **Large Shade Trees**



Option B

1 tree/ 750 sq. ft. of landscaped area

Large + Medium + Small 1 tree/ 625 sq. ft. of landscaped area No more than 1/3 of the required trees may be small trees




Street Trees



Same size tree credit allowed for street trees in lieu of onsite trees * Includes trees planted on street median

Shrubs



75% must be planted in interior parking lot landscaping islands or be included in the required bufferyard.

Tree Removal A clearing and grading permit is required for the removal of any trees. A 6" DBH or larger tree inventory

applying for the permit. Tree Protection Saved trees within 40 feet of construction



4 ft. or more.

Protective fencing is required if construction is near the root system or within 20 feet of saved trees.
*No materials used for construction or waste

materials from construction are allowed within the limits of the critical root zone of protected trees.
