CITY MANAGER'S REPORT

1. Downtown area received the National Accredited Main Street Program – Score 110 of 123 possible.

- 2. The City is now processing its fourth filming permit for this FY. It is a Discovery Channel documentary, and they will be here for a week in late February. They are also hiring local help for the week they are here and renting sites for interviews.
- 3. Communication has launched a new program called "Called to Serve" on TV Channel 3 and the City social websites.
- 4. The City secured the last easement needed for construction on the Lake Street culvert replacement project. The bids were received last week, and the council award and contract phase is expected to go through March. Construction is anticipated to start in April and be completed in July.
- 5. Following a period of heavy rains, the Lake Palestine raw water geosmin count spiked at 414 ppb during the week of January 23, 2017. After treatment, the geosmin count was reduced to 11 ppb, achieving 97% removal of the geosmin. Such a significant geosmin removal has not been achieved by this plant in the past 14 years, and is a testament to the progress the Water Production staff has made to utilize all the treatment techniques available to effectively treat the City's water supply.
