

RESOLUTION NO. R-2019-67

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, APPOINTING A MEMBER TO THE SMITH COUNTY APPRAISAL DISTRICT (SCAD) BOARD OF DIRECTORS; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 6.03 of the Texas Property Tax Code establishes the selection process for Appraisal District Directors; and

WHEREAS, the taxing units of Smith County have adopted a seven-member Board of Directors with the City of Tyler entitled to select one member of that Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, an Appraisal District Director must reside in the appraisal district for at least two years prior to taking office; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Heines has recommended that Mark Whatley be re-appointed as the City's representative to the Smith County Appraisal District Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, the below named individual is the City of Tyler's selection for appointment to the Smith County Appraisal District (SCAD) Board;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:

PART 1: That Mark Whatley is hereby selected as the City of Tyler representative on the Smith County Appraisal District to serve a two-year term beginning January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2021.

PART 2: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council.


PART 3: That the City Manager is hereby directed to provide a copy of this Resolution to the Smith County Appraisal District.
