AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, DECLARING THE RESULTS OF AN ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, ON THE 5th DAY OF MAY, 2018, FOR THE ELECTION OF A MAYOR AT LARGE AND CITY COUNCILMEMBERS FOR DISTRICTS NO. 2, 4 AND 6, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:

- **PART 1:** That <u>Martin Heines</u> be and is hereby declared the duly elected Mayor at Large, to serve for a two-year term of office.
- **PART 2:** That <u>Broderick McGee</u> be and is hereby declared the duly elected City Councilmember for District No. 2, to serve for a two-year term of office.
- **PART 3:** That **Don Warren** be and is hereby declared the duly elected City Councilmember for District No. 4, to serve for a two-year term of office.
- **PART 4:** That <u>John Nix</u> be and is hereby declared the duly elected City Councilmember for District No. 6, to serve for a two-year term of office.

PART 5: That the above named Mayor at Large and City Councilmembers for Districts No. 2, 4, and 6 shall be sworn into office and shall each serve for a two-year term of office.

PART 6: That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
