

RESOLUTION NO. R-2020-86

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, RATIFYING ACCEPTANCE OF, TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (TxDOT) ROUTINE AIRPORT MAINTAINENCE PROGRAM (RAMP) GRANT TOTALING \$50,000 FOR GENERAL ROUTINE MAINTENANCE PROJECTS AT TYLER POUNDS REGIONAL AIRPORT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The Texas Department of Transportation has offered a \$50,000 RAMP Grant for the maintenance of Tyler Pounds Regional Airport; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of this grant to not supplant local funds normally utilized for airport maintenance, and that any state financial assistance offered under this grant be in addition to those local funds normally dedicated for airport maintenance; and

WHEREAS, on September 21, 2020, the Airport Advisory Board recommended that the City Council ratify funding for the purpose of general routine maintenance at Tyler Pounds Regional Airport; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City Council to ratify acceptance of the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Routine Annual Maintenance Program (RAMP) Grant and

WHEREAS, it is considered to be in the public interest to obtain and use grant funds for the above public purposes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Council hereby resolves and affirms to the Texas Department of Transportation that the City of Tyler has legal authority to finance and carry out the proposed projects.

PART 4: That the City Council hereby resolves and affirms to the Texas Department of Transportation the City of Tyler's intent to comply with all of the assurances set forth in the grant agreement and all laws, regulations, and circulars incorporated by reference in the grant agreement.

PART 5: That the City Manager's acceptance of the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Routine Annual Maintenance Program (RAMP) Grant, is hereby authorized.


PART 6: That the City of Tyler has been informed that there is a \$50,000 City of Tyler match.

PART 7: That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take all actions necessary in order to accept and use the grant to fulfill the purposes described above.

PART 8: That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to provide such additional information as may be required by the Texas Department of Transportation.


PART 9: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
