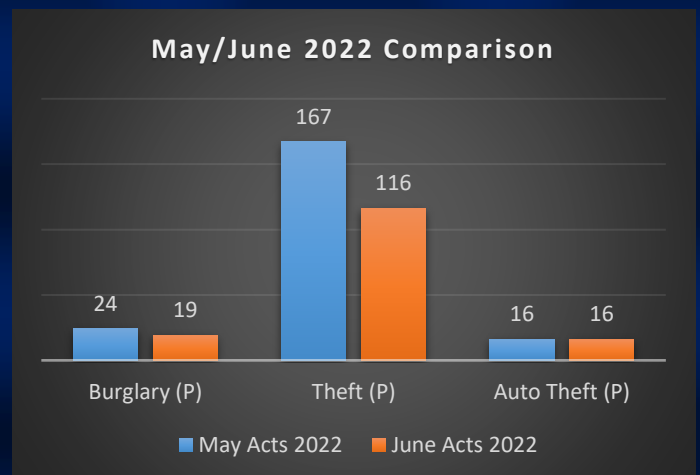
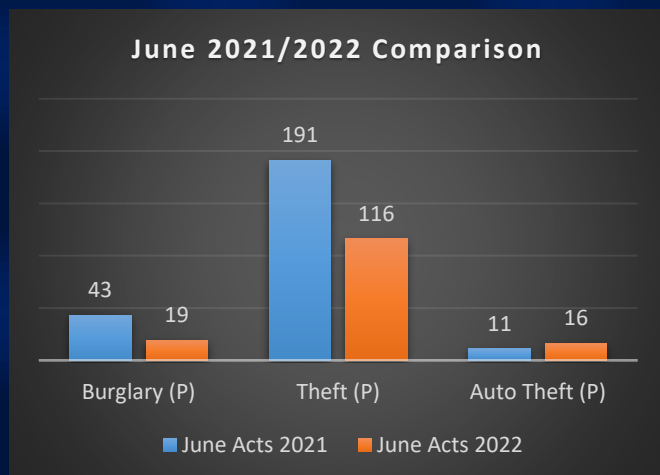

There is a downward trend for part 1 property crimes when comparing June 2022 to June 2021 and May 2022.

In June 2022, overall property crimes had a decrease of 38% compared to June 2021 and had a 27% decrease compared to May 2022.

There was an increase in auto theft (45%) offenses when comparing June 2022 to June 2021. There was a decrease in burglary (-56%) and theft (-39%) offenses when comparing June 2022 to June 2021.

There was a decrease in burglary (-21%) and theft (-31%) offenses when comparing June 2022 to May 2022. There was no change in auto theft offenses when comparing June 2022 to May 2022.
