

RESOLUTION NO. R-2022-27

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, ALSO REFERRED TO AS "APPLICANT", AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR THE EAST TEXAS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS REGIONAL SOLID WASTE GRANTS PROGRAM FOR FUNDS TO BE USED FOR SOLID WASTE AND THE 2023 PAINT RECYCLE EVENT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS; PLEDGING THAT IF A GRANT IS RECEIVED THE CITY OF TYLER WILL COMPLY WITH THE GRANT REQUIREMENTS OF THE EAST TEXAS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS, THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY AND THE STATE OF TEXAS; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the East Texas Council of Governments is directed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality to administer solid waste grant funds for implementation the Council of Government's adopted regional solid waste management plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tyler ("City") is fully eligible to apply for grant funds under the Request for Applications; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tyler wishes to participate in the aforementioned grant program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tyler will be applying for approximately \$20,000.00 to allow for solid waste use and for the 2023 paint recycling day; and

WHEREAS, City of Tyler will comply with the grant requirements of the East Texas Council of Governments, Texas Commission on Environmental Quality and the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City is desirous of authorizing an official or representee to act for the City in dealing with the East Texas Council of Governments regional solid waste management grant program; and

WHEREAS, it is considered to be in the public interest to apply for, obtain and use grant funds for the above public purposes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City hereby certifies and directs the City Manager or designee to act for the City in dealing with the East Texas Council of Governments for the purposes of this grant program, and that the City Manager or designee is hereby officially designated as the representative in this regard.

PART 2. That the City hereby specifically authorizes the City Manager or designee to make application to request grant funding in the amount of \$20,000.00 under the East Texas Council of Governments Request for Applications of the Regional Solid Waste Grants Program, act on behalf of the City of Tyler in all matters related to the grant application, and any subsequent grant contracts and/or grant projects that may result.

PART 3. That the City hereby resolves and affirms that if the Regional Solid Waste Grants is awarded to the City, the City of Tyler will comply with the grant requirements of the East Texas Council of Governments, Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, and the State of Texas.

PART 4. That the grant funds and any grant-funded equipment or facilities will be used only for the purposes for which they are intended under the grant.

PART 5. That activities will comply with and support the adopted regional and local solid waste management plans adopted for the geographical area in which the activities are performed.

PART 6. That the City of Tyler Solid Waste Department is hereby authorized and directed to accept the grant if awarded, and any grant amendments to increase the funding levels.

PART 7. That the Solid Waste Department is hereby authorized and directed to take all actions necessary to accept the grant to fulfill the purposes described above, if awarded.

PART 8. That the Solid Waste Department is hereby authorized and directed to provide such additional information as may be required by the East Texas Council of Governments, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, and/or the State of Texas.

PART 9. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
