

RESOLUTION NO. R-2022-37

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION BY THE TYLER POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR, AND ACCEPTANCE OF, FUNDING FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE THROUGH THE EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT TO FUND THE PURCHASE OF: TEN (10) GETAC A140 IN-CAR COMPUTERS WITH ACCESSORIES; DESIGNATING THE CITY MANAGER AS THE CITY'S AUTHORIZED OFFICIAL; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY ACTIONS RELATED TO ACCEPTANCE AND USE OF THE GRANT; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Tyler finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Tyler that the established Justice Assistance Grant Funding be utilized for 2022-2023 year; and

WHEREAS, The City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, The Tyler City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full; and

WHEREAS, The City Council designates the Tyler City Manager as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency; and

WHEREAS, The Criminal Justice Division Justice Assistance Grant will fund the proposed equipment in the amount of \$55,000 for one year only, after which additional funding must be reapplied for; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TYLER, TEXAS;

PART 1: That the City Council of the City of Tyler approves the acceptance of Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant funding through the Department of Justice and that said Grant is not to exceed \$55,000.00 to assist in funding ten (10) GeTac A140 in-car computers with accessories for the Tyler Police Department for one year.

PART 2: That the City Manager is hereby designated as the City of Tyler's authorized official, and is hereby authorized to apply for, reject, alter, terminate, and/or take all necessary actions related to the grant on behalf of the City of Tyler;

PART 3: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
